Developing Enterprise Education in your School.

The National Enterprise School Award comprises 10 Enterprise Standards and facilitates the audit and development of whole school practice. The NESA is the sister Award to the National Enterprise Teacher Award (NETA), supported by Loughborough University, Young Enterprise, MyBnk, Peter Jones Foundation and other leading organisations.

Each Standard is linked to a set of attributes, which help to focus and signpost the evidence you will need to collect to successfully complete the Award.

For example:

NESA 1: The school has created a vision and policy for enterprise education

Attributes:

Summarise the school minimum entitlement which shows enterprise education is provided for all students

Provide a copy of the school definition of enterprise education, including evidence of staff consultation on an agreed definition

Provide a copy of school policies that relate to enterprise education

Provide a copy of references to enterprise education within school planning documentation

The other 9 standards are:

The vision for enterprise education is communicated to all stakeholders

The school has undertaken a full audit of enterprise education

The school has an identified enterprise lead, supported by the leadership team

The school allocates specific resources to encourage and support enterprise education activity

The school enterprise education activities develop economic and financial understanding

The enterprise education activities develop a full range of enterprise capabilities

Pupil/student enterprise learning is regularly reviewed, assessed and recorded

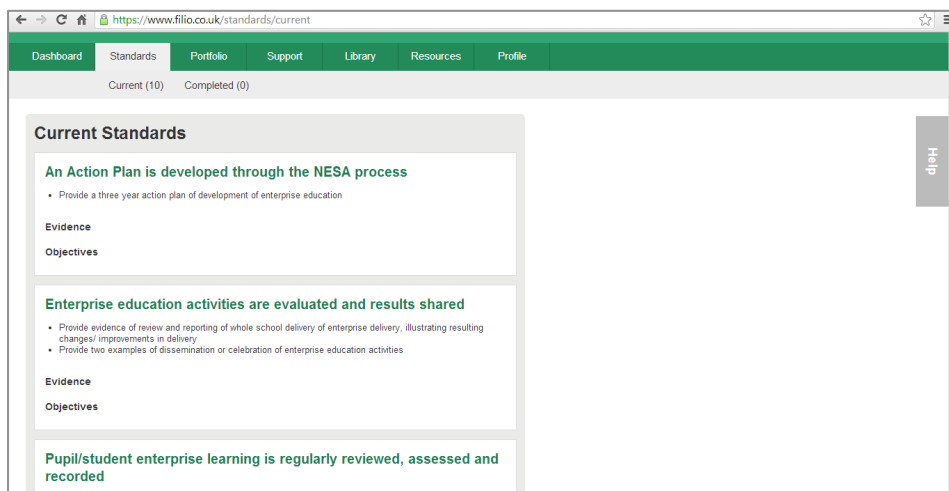
Enterprise education activities are evaluated and results shared

An Action Plan is developed through the NESA process

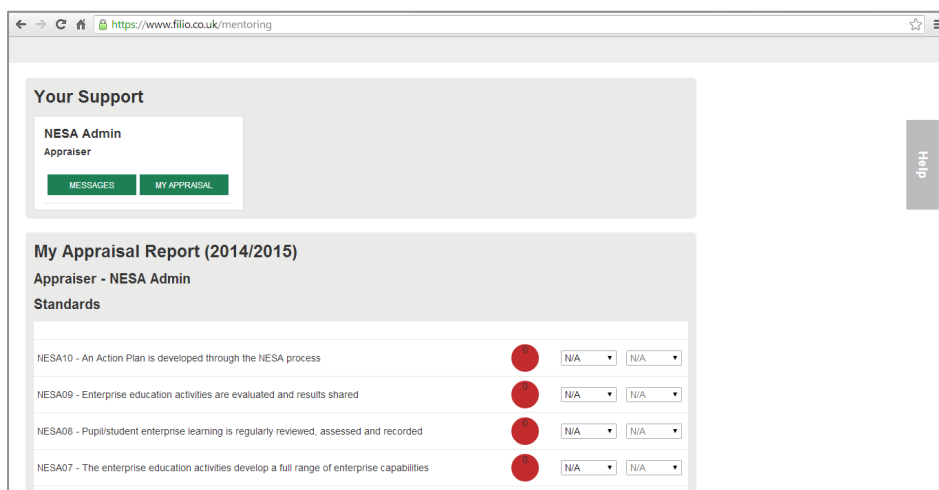
Schools working towards the NESA will have access to an on-line portfolio to enable you to build a record of practice. You will also have access to a **Resource** section, which keeps all the information you need in one place including guidance and support to help you develop enterprise education in your school

All schools taking part will be assigned a mentor, who will work with you and offer advice and support. When you are ready you can submit your portfolio and your mentor will provide feedback and an action plan for future development. When all the Standards are signed off you will receive the nationally recognised NESA award.

You will be supported through the process and receive an action plan, when you are ready for submission.
