## Supporting, developing and recognising your skills in Enterprise Education

The National Enterprise Teacher Award, NETA, provides a framework to guide and develop effective teaching practice in enterprise education. Taking a practical and learner centred approach the standards will help you focus on developing skills to engage and encourage students inside and outside the classroom.

By collecting evidence of activities and reflecting on your own approach, you can quickly and easily build a personal portfolio of evidence and gain recognition for your work. Working towards the NETA contributes to professional development and enables you to collect and store useful resources – adding to the range of tried and tested activities provided by NETA.

### The NETA Standards

NETA 1: Enable students to think and act in enterprising ways

NETA 2: Provide the opportunity for work related learning, both in and outside the classroom


NETA 3: Provide the opportunity for students to participate in entrepreneurial experiences

NETA 4: Provide students with the opportunity to develop a range enterprise skills and knowledge

NETA 5: Demonstrate an enterprising approach to teaching and learning

NETA 6: Evaluate impact of enterprise learning and demonstrate how this impacts on delivery

NETA 7: Provide a case study of an enterprise project you have developed

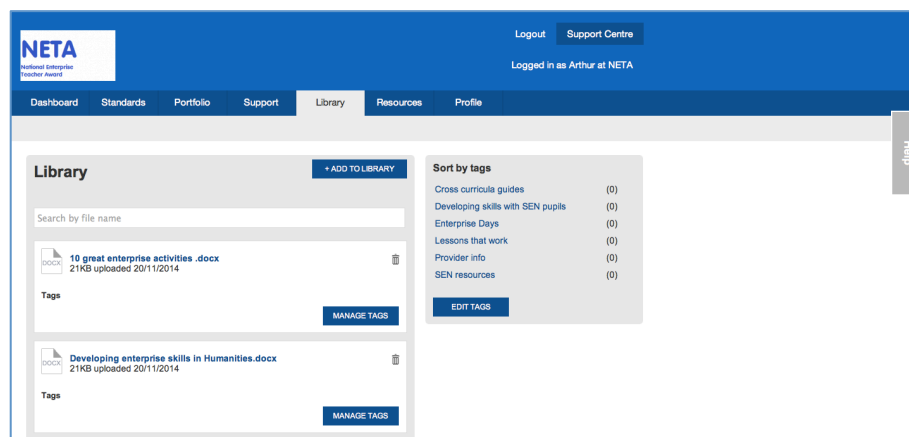
Each standard also has 3 or 4 attributes, which help guide activity.

## Your own on line Portfolio and resource centre.

Registering for the NETA gives access to your own on-line portfolio, which contains all the information you need to build up a record of effective practice. You will be assigned a mentor to offer support and advice.

Access to the NETA Resource centre with activities and guidance will help you develop enterprise education with your students; you can copy documents, edit and store them in your own Library.

When you are ready you can submit your portfolio and your mentor will provide feedback and a simple action plan for future development. When the Standards are completed and signed off you will receive a NETA certificate. You can continue to access your portfolio including the resources for further professional development and reference, saving time and stress when planning lessons and activities in the future.

## What does it cost?

Registering for the NETA is £100 (+vat) per teacher – this includes an individual on line portfolio, access to resources and updates and certification.
